Slovakia (SK)	Required for at least one driven axle	15 November until 31 March

Sweden (SE)	Required for the driven axle(s) in winter conditions (snow, wet snow or ice)	1 December until 31 March
Switzerland (CH)	Required in winter conditions on all axles of vehicle and trailers	1 December until 31 March
